Accessing Training

Medical practitioners participating in voluntary assisted dying must successfully complete the Voluntary Assisted Dying Mandatory Medical Practitioner Training.

Before you start

To complete the mandatory training you'll need to:

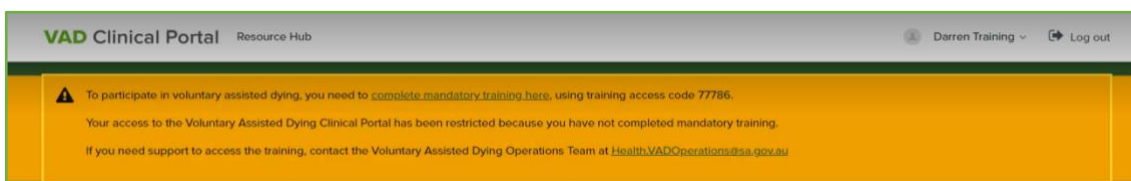
- have registered for the VAD Clinical Portal
- been assessed as eligible by the Department for Health and Wellbeing
- have received an '**Account Created**' email from health.vadnoreply@sahealth.sa.gov.au
- activated your VAD Clinical Portal account.

How to access the training

Step 1: Locate your training details

1. Log into the VAD Clinical Portal.
2. Locate your **training access code** in the yellow training banner at the top of your screen.
3. Click the **complete mandatory training** hyperlink in the yellow training banner at the top of your screen.

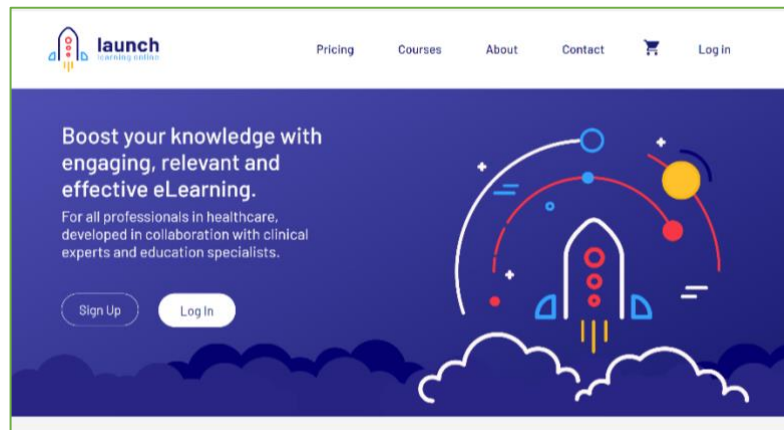

Enter your details, including:

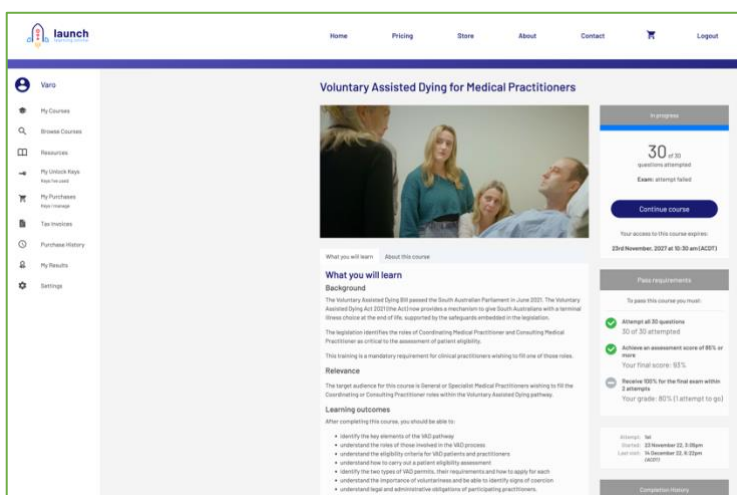
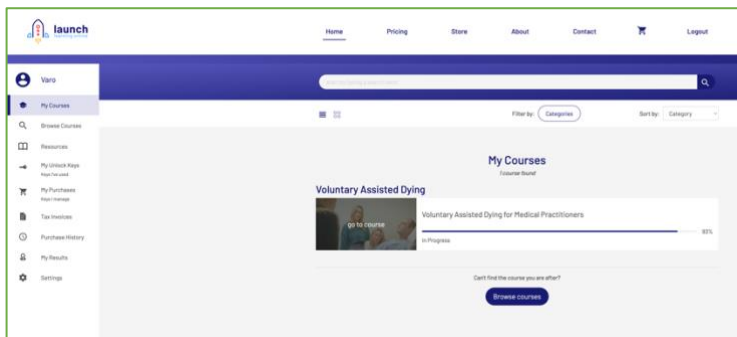
- name

The Voluntary Assisted Dying for Medical Practitioner training will now be available for you to commence.



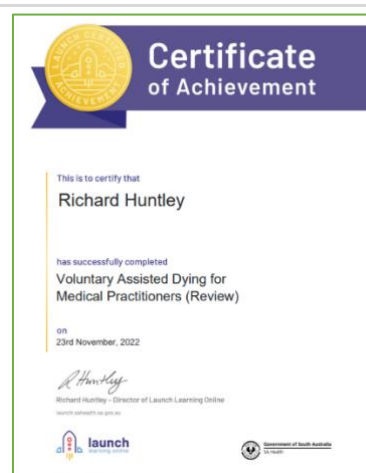
Step 5: Complete training
