

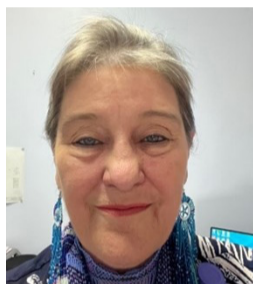
# Our Service Planning Advisory Group.

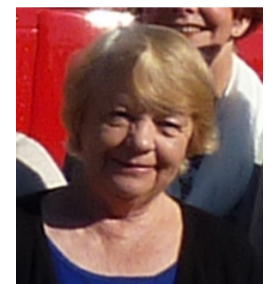
