Transition of Flinders Medical Centre Cardiology Clinics

For many years, Cardiology Clinics have been predominantly delivered via the Flinders Cardiac Clinic, private group in FPH (Flinders Private Hospital).

From Monday 1 January 2024, the operational management of the Cardiology Clinics will be split as follows:

- 1. the SALHN (public) cardiology clinic on the Flinders site will be relocating to new clinic rooms located at Suite **601**, FPH. This is next door to the current Flinders Cardiac Clinic (Suite 606, FPH).
- 2. private cardiology clinics will continue to operate at FPH. Please note that from 1 January 2024 all referrals addressed to Flinders Cardiac Clinic will be managed as private referrals.

Every effort will be made to get the right patient into the right clinic, in accordance with the patient and referrer's wishes.

Acknowledging that some public referrals will inevitably still find their way to Flinders Cardiac, we want to offer reassurance that even after Monday 1 January 2024, Flinders Cardiac will routinely forward referrals that mention 'public', or SALHN, or FMC, or any such indication that the referrer intends their referral to be 'public', to the new SALHN cardiology clinic.

For patients seeking public outpatient Cardiology services, the following details must be used from Monday 1 January 2024 onwards:

FMC Cardiology Clinic

- all public cardiology referrals can already be received at this fax number.

Patients previously seen at the FMC Cardiology Clinic have also been made aware of this transition via letter:

- 1. Patients will be contacted by a SALHN staff member over the coming months and offered their next appointment in the new FMC Cardiology Clinic rooms (FPH, Suite **601**).
- 2. Patients may be asked to bring an updated referral from their General Practitioner to their appointment, which would include an updated list of medical issues and medications.

The SALHN Outpatient clinic list and Cardiology clinic webpage have been updated accordingly.


