### **Description of Service:**

Modbury Hospital is the primary site for palliative care services within NALHN, though services are provided at both Lyell McEwin Hospital and Modbury Hospital.

Multidisciplinary support services are available in the acute hospital and community setting

#### Services Provided Include:

- > Medical Consulting
- > Nurse Led Clinics
- > Multidisciplinary Clinics
- > Community Support Services.

- > Referrals must be submitted using the specified Palliative Care Service Referral Form
- > Please always ensure that referrals provide an alternative contact for the patient in the event of cognitive impairment
- > Please include copies of all reports and results and a clearly stated reason for the referral
- > Referrals should provide as much information as possible to ensure accurate referral and timely access.
