Partnering with Griffith Rehabilitation Hospital

We are creating extra space on our Rehabilitation and Aged Care wards by partnering with Griffith Rehabilitation Hospital (Healthscope). This is a private 55-bed rehabilitation hospital located in Hove.

How could this impact you?

During your stay, our team may need to arrange, at short notice, for you to be transferred to Griffith Rehabilitation Hospital to complete your inpatient stay.

This will only occur if the therapy provided by Griffith Rehabilitation Hospital is comparable to what you are receiving with us, and it is safe to do so.

Transfer to Griffith Hospital

Our health care team will arrange a detailed clinical handover for your transfer to Griffith Rehabilitation Hospital to ensure your move is as smooth as possible.

We will also arrange transport for your transfer and contact your support person to let them know what is happening. You will continue to have the same access to our early supported discharge services and post discharge rehabilitation services.

What to expect at Griffith Rehabilitation Hospital?

The therapy provided is comparable to what you are receiving with us. Griffith Rehabilitation Hospital has a mixture of single and share rooms. There will be no cost to you for your stay. You will only need to pay for any discharge medications, which is the same as all our inpatients.
