

Amyloid Cardiomyopathy Clinic - Cardiology Southern Adelaide Local Health Network (SALHN)

Service Overview

- Referrals will be accepted from non-GP specialists only
- Clinical assessment for diagnosis and management of Amyloid Transthyretin (ATTR) Amyloidosis or Amyloid Light Chains (AL) Amyloidosis
- Consideration and patient education regarding diagnostic endomyocardial biopsy
- Access to clinical trials, enrolling for novel cardiac amyloid therapy (i.e. Tafamidis, AG10)
- Genetic screening for familial ATTR amyloidosis

Inclusion Criteria

- Cardiac tissue (AL/ATTR) or bone scan (ATTR, Perugini score ≥ 2) amyloid diagnosis

Exclusion Criteria

- Cognitive degenerative disease (i.e. dementing illness)
- Patient already under the care of another cardiologist (unless referred by the responsible cardiologist)

Investigations Required *(if possible, please provide results with referral)*

Cardiac assessment including:

- Echocardiogram
- Cardiac Magnetic Resonance Imaging (CMR)
- Bone Scintigraphy
- Holter Monitor
- Blood work (GFR, latest creatinine, EUC, Serum protein electrophoresis, Light chain kappa and Lambda, Troponin, NT proBNP, Bence Jones Protein)
- Medication list
