

Disability Assessment and Planning

NDIS Rehabilitation Physician Review – Clinic commences June 2018

- Conditions with Long term Disability requiring specialist review for NDIS (evaluation and/or planning of care requirements)

The Clinic will assess and assist in the rehabilitation and disability management of patients with long term disability, patients with disability on chronic management plans; provide opinion on prognosis/permanency of disability; and evaluate and report on impact(s) of disability on function and work capacity.

Information Required

- Named referral, if specific Consultant required
- Diagnosis and Management
- Current medications
- Allergies
- Past medical history
- Communication and/or language difficulties
- Need for interpreter
- Social background/work status
- **INCLUDE RELEVANT SPECIALIST REPORTS**






Investigations Required

- Previous specialist reports/letters
- Hospital and Rehabilitation discharge summaries
- Neuro-imaging and relevant radiology reports
- Results of special investigations (e.g. Nerve conduction studies, EMG, EEG, Neuropsychology, Urodynamics etc)
