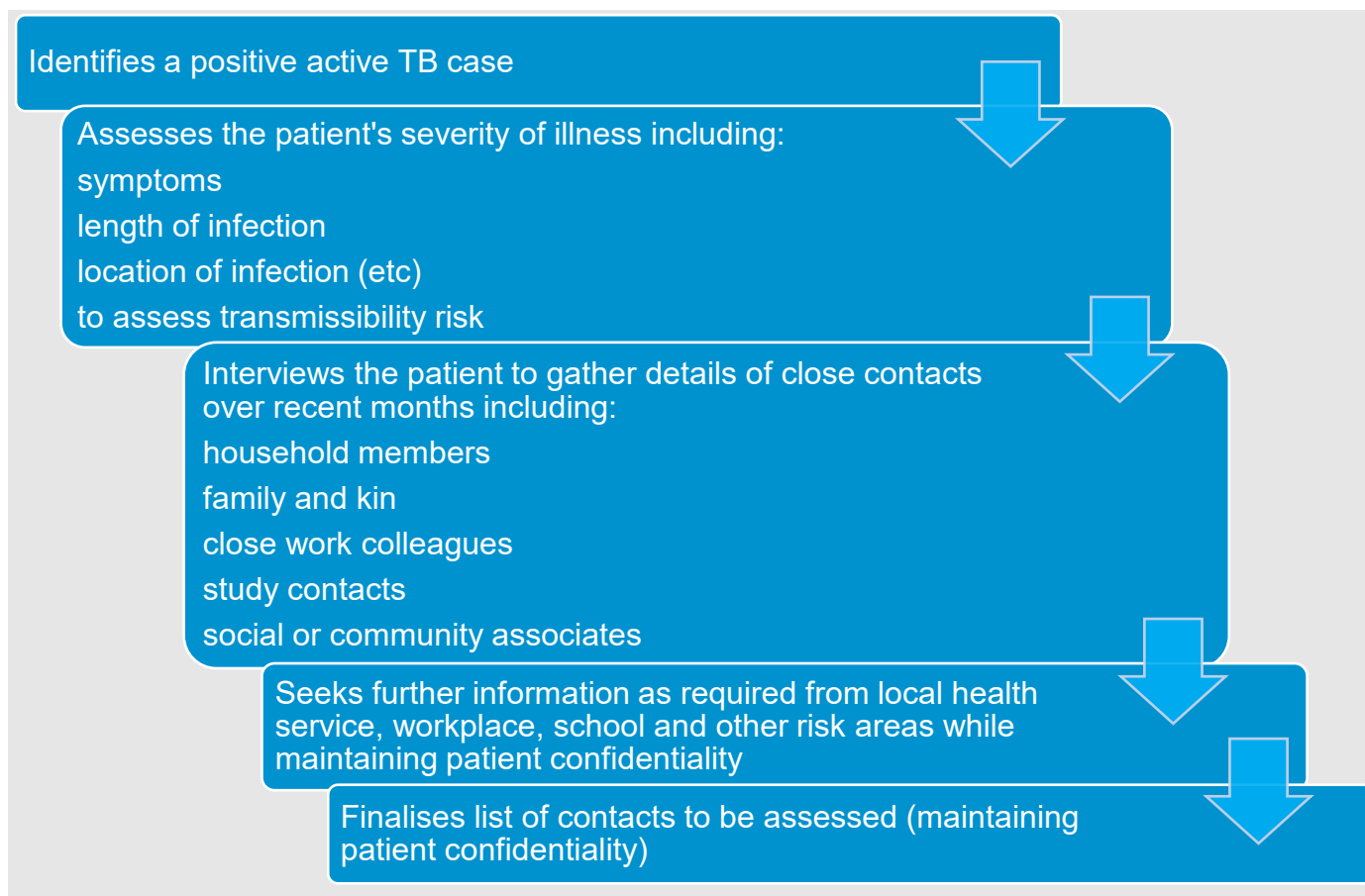
Tuberculosis contact tracing

South Australian Tuberculosis Services (SA TB Services) manages all contact tracing for tuberculosis (TB) across the state.

They may ask for advice from local health workers in various regions, which can be valuable to the process.

SA TB Services don't expect health workers to conduct TB contact tracing. Contact tracing will always be done under the direction from SA TB Services as there is intensive training involved.
