Is the human research low risk or higher risk?

Low Risk

- No risk of harm or discomfort to participants, their carers/family (physical, psychological, cultural, social, economic and legal) or the Site
- Potential for minor burden or inconvenience
- Managed out of session, submit anytime

Higher Risk

- Multi sites studies where SALHN is a contributing site including registries.
- Commercially sponsored clinical drug trials and Collaborative interventions requiring significant exchange of services
- Review by Human Research Ethics Committee
