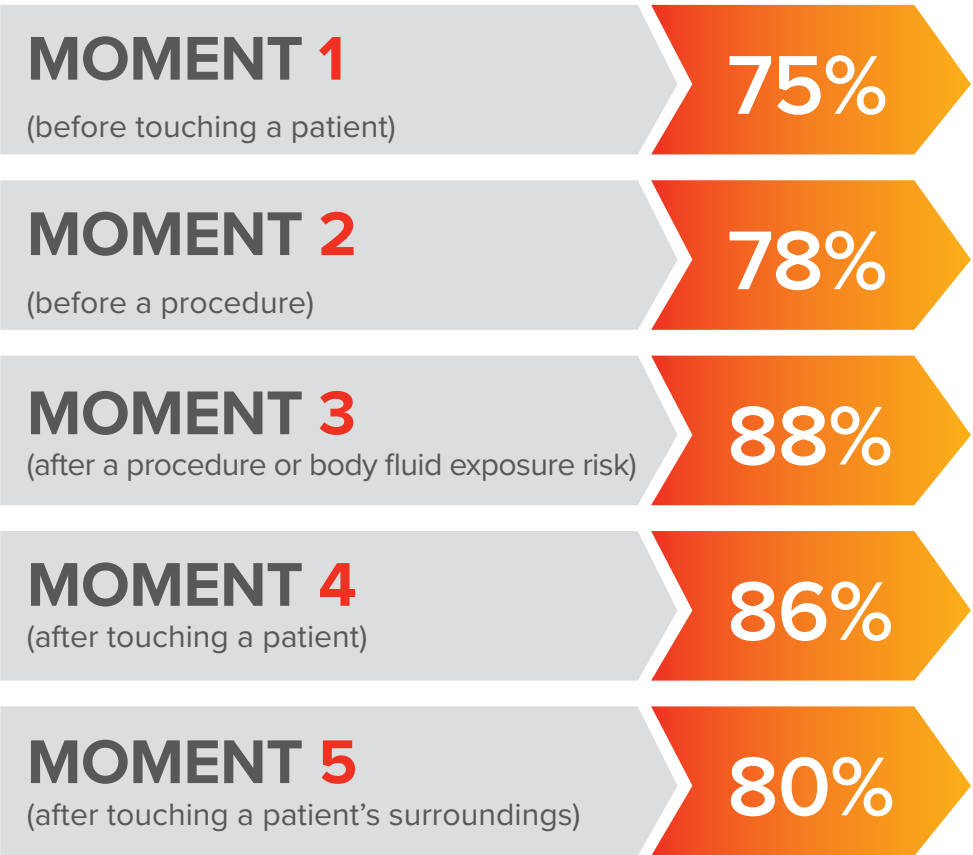


WHY IS HAND HYGIENE IMPORTANT?



Hand hygiene, as part of infection prevention and control, has a demonstrated impact on quality of care and patient safety across all levels of the health system.

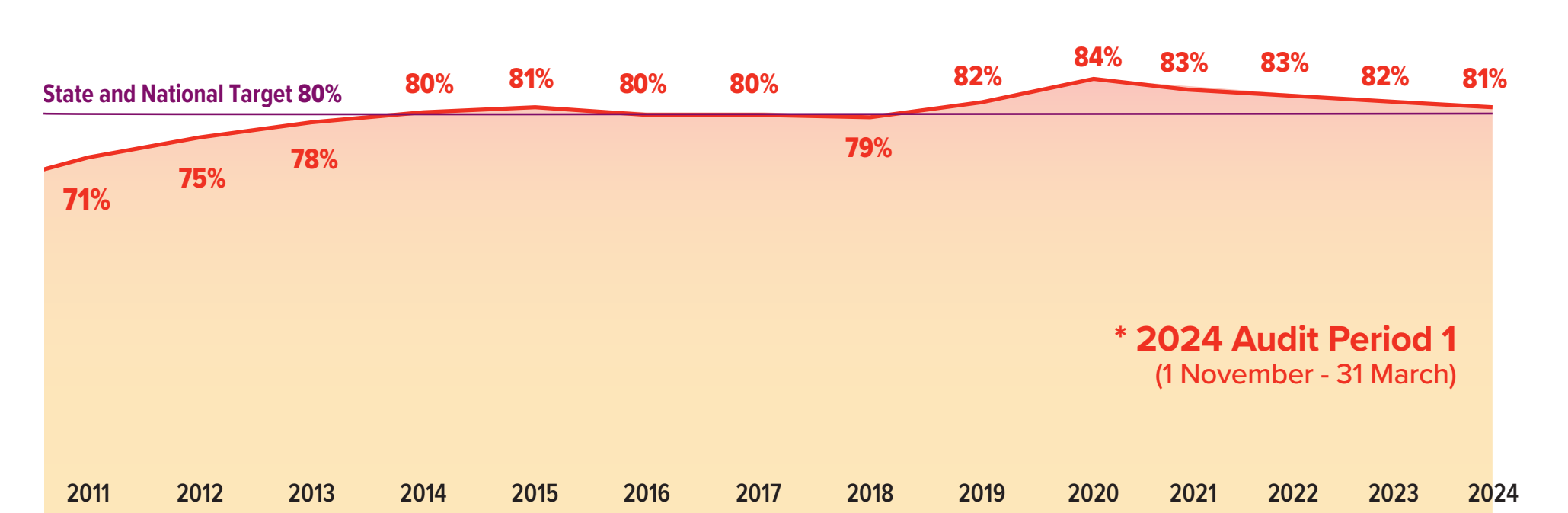
COMPLIANCE AS PER THE 5 MOMENTS FOR HAND HYGIENE*
