

## Liver and pancreatic tumours

### Information Required

- Associated symptoms – pain or painless, weight loss
- Recent onset of diabetes, symptoms of steatorrhoea
- History of previous malignancy, hepatitis or liver disease
- Findings on general and abdominal examination

### Investigations Required

- Electrolytes, creatinine, LFTs, FBE, INR
- Liver and biliary tract US
- Contrast abdominal CT scan desirable
